Know all Men by these Presents, That we Albert C. Baldock and his wife Ann Bell Baldock of Madison County and State of Iowa Six hundred Mary J. Guilliams of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The North East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South East quarter section ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No Eight (8) and five acres situated in the North West corner of the South West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West quarter section ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No nine (9) and also three acres off of the South end of the East half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No Eight (8) and also one and one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) acres off of the South end of the East half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the West half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No eight (8) in township Sixty-five (75) North of Range (26) Twenty-six West

And we hereby covenant with the said Mary J. Guilliams

that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Ann Bell Baldock hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
