 eration of the sum of Thirteen Hund-
 red Dollars, in hand paid by William H. Bishop of Madison
 County and State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the
 said William H. Bishop, the following described premises
 situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa,
 to-wit: The North half of the North West quarter of Section
 Fifteen (15) and the North West quarter of the North West
 quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty-
 four (34) all in Township Seventy four (74) Range
 twenty six (26) West of 5th P.M. Iowa.

And I hereby covenant with the said William
 H. Bishop, that I hold said premises by good and
 perfect title, that I have good right and lawful
 authority to sell and convey the same, that
 they are free and clear of all liens and incumbr-
 ances whatever; and I covenant to warrant
 and defend the said premises against the
 lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
