Know all Men by these Presents, That we Samuel M. Walker and Caroline Walker of Madison County and State of Iowa were in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by James Plymell of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said James Plymell

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

South West of the North East quarter of Sec. (24) Twenty four being Forty Acres more or less, and also Ten Acres off of the South side of the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Twenty four all in Township Seventy four (74) Range Twenty seven (27)

And we hereby covenant with the said James Plymell that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Caroline Walker hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
