the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The South East quarter of the North West gr and the North East gr of the South West gr of section Thirteen (13) Township No 77 North of Range Twenty nine (29) West

And we hereby covenant with the said Pierce Long

that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Lydia McRimney hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
