Lot numbered two (2) in Block numbered one (1) in Ginters' Addition to the town of Winterset, in said County of Madison Iowa, with the appurtenances, and all the Estate, Title, and interest therein of the said party of the first part, and the said Lewis B. Amberg, and Sarah Amberg, parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree to and with, the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns that the said premises thus conveyed, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, they will forever warrant and defend against any person whomsoever, claiming the same or any part thereof.
