Iowa I do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said**

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the River 460 links East of  
the South West corner of the North West quarter of section  
(No 36) in Township Seventy six (76) North of Range twenty  
seven (27) West of the 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian Thence

North 145 links three East Parallel with the South  
line of said quarter 214 links thence South 145 links three
