I know all men by these presents, that we John Linnan and Julia Linnan of Polk County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars, in hand paid, do

hereby sell and convey unto Patrick Linnan, of Polk County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to wit:

The West half of the North West quarter, of Section No. Thirty three (33) in township No. Twenty seven (77) North of Range No. Twenty six (26) West of S. P. M. Ioway.

And we do hereby covenant with the said Patrick Linnan, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have a good, right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whosoever; And the said Julia Linnan hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
