Know all men by these presents, that we, David Baker and Minerva Baker, his wife, of Madison County and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and

Sixty Dollars, in hand paid by Martha Hallinbeck, of Madison County and State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the said Martha Hallinbeck, the following described premises situated in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The South half (1/2) of the South West Fourth (1/4) of the North West quarter, (1/4) of Section number Fifteen (15) in Township No. Twenty Five (25) North of Range Twenty six (26) West of Fifth (5) Principal Meridian, containing twenty (20) acres more or less.

And we hereby covenant with the said Martha Hallinbeck that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority to sell and convey the same, that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatever; and we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever; and the said Minerva Baker, hereby relinquishes her rights of dower in and to the above described premises.
