Meridian Situate in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, —
And we do hereby covenant ~~to~~ and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Sarah A. Brinson hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
