 and assigns forever the certain tract or parcel of Real Estate in
 the County of Madison State of Iowa to wit The South East Quar-
 ter of Section Twenty (20) in Township Seventy four (74) North and
 Range Twenty six (26) West of the fifth Principal meridian contain-
 ing one hundred and sixty acres more or less to have and to hold
 the premises above described with all the appurtenances thereto belong-
 ing unto him the said second party and to his heirs and assigns
 forever The said Simon A. Bagley and Almira Bagley hereby con-
 manteeing for their heirs executors and administrators that the
 the above described premises are free from all incumbrances that
 they have full right power and authority to sell the same and they
 will warrant and defend the title unto the said party of the
 second part his heirs and assigns against the claims of all persons
 whomever lawfully claiming the same. And the said Almira
 Bagley Wife of the said Simon A. Bagley hereby relinquishes and
 releases all her right of Dower in and to the foregoing described premises
