Know all Men by these Presents, That we John A Pitzer & Elizabeth Pitzer husband and wife of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, in hand paid, by Sarah Smith of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Sarah Smith the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: Block number Twenty Two (22) in Pitzer and Remig's addition to the town of Winterset

And we hereby covenant with the said Sarah Smith that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Elizabeth Pitzer hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
