Know all men by these presents, that we George North and Elizabeth North of Polk County, and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars in hand paid

by Cyrus Blaker, of Polk County & State of Iowa, do hereby sell & convey unto the said Cyrus Blaker the following described premises, lying in Madison County, Iowa, to-wit: the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section No. Thirty four (34) Township No. Twenty seven (27) Range No. Twenty Eight (28). Also the following described real estate, commencing twenty rods West of the South East corner of the South East quarter of Section No. Twenty one (21) Township No. Twenty seven (27) North of Range No. Twenty Eight (28) West of the 5d P. M. Iowa, running thence Thirteen & one half (13½) rods, West, thence Sixty (60) rods, North, thence Thirteen & one half (13½) rods East, thence Sixty (60) rods South to the place of beginning, containing Five (5) Acres, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and the said Elizabeth North hereby relinquishes all her rights of dower in and to the abovescribed premises.
