Twenty one (21) in Township twenty four of Range Twenty eight (28) being
in the District of lands which were subject to sale at Charlton

the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and propeleges
therunto belonging or in anywise thereto appertaining and all the

the first hereby expressly warrant release and relinquish unto the said
