Be it remembered that by virtue of an execution to me di-
 rected issued from the District Court of said County and re-
 ceived the 5th day of April in a case wherein Thomas Gordon
 was plaintiff and James Gordon was defendant commanding me
 to levy the same upon the goods chattels lands and tenements of
 said James Gordon to satisfy the judgment interests and costs in
 the above cause and for want of sufficient personal property
 wherein to levy to satisfy the same I did on the 5th day of April
 1866 levy the said writ of execution upon the following described

 after mentioned in the Warsaw Madisonian a newspaper pub-
 lished in the County of Madison Iowa and posted up notice
 of the said sale in three public places in said County of Madison
 Iowa one of which places being in the same township in which

said property is situated and are being on the front door
 of the court house in said County of Madison the place where
 the last District court of said County was held as required by law
 I did on the 5th day of May 1846 between the hours of 9 o'clock

the authority aforesaid might could or should or ought to sell and
