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Know all Men by these presents, that  
Valeria Nosler whereas one Valeria Nosler instituted a suit  
in the District Court of Madison County Iowa, on  
the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1865, against William H. Evans to compel the  
said Evans to execute to her for Lots Three and Four (3 & 4) in Block  
No Four (4) in Petzer & Knights Addition to the City of Winterset  
Madison County Iowa, and whereas the District Court of Madison County  
Iowa, at its October term 1866, ordered adjudged and decreed in said  
cause that the said Evans convey by good and sufficient deed, said Lots  
to said Valeria Nosler within ~~an~~ days from the rising of said  
Court and in default of the said Evans making said deed, as ordered  
by the Court, the Clerk of the District Court of Madison County Iowa,

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was appointed as a Commissioner to make and execute said deed, and whereas said Evans has failed to make said deed as ordered by the Court. Now therefore I, M. R. Tidrick Clerk of the District Court of Madison County Iowa, by virtue of the authority and power conferred upon me by said decree, and for the purpose of carrying the same into effect do hereby for the consideration of One dollar to me in hand paid by the said Valeria Nosler, and the further consideration of the premises aforesaid, convey to Valeria Nosler said Lots No Three and Four (3 & 4) in Block No Four (4) in Pitzer & Knights Addition to the City of Winterset Iowa, To have and to hold to her and her heirs and assigns forever. Witness my hand this 1<sup>st</sup> day of December 1866.
