Gaumer of the same place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said — heirs and assigns forever, The following premises situate in the County of Madison in the State of Iowa, and bounded and described as follows; The South East quarter of the South East quarter; and the West half of the South West quarter of Section Twenty eight (28) in Township Seventy seven (77) North of Range No Twenty eight (28) West of the fifth Principal Meridian, containing One hundred and twenty (120) Acres of Land more or less, and all the Estate, Title and Interest of the said Abraham Evans and Elizabeth M. Evans either in law or equity, of, in and to the said premises; Together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, and all the rents, issues and profits thereof, To have and to hold the same to the only proper use of the said William Warren and C. B. Gaumer and their heirs and assigns forever. And the said Abraham Evans for himself and for his heirs, executors and administrators doth hereby covenant with the said William Warren and C. B. Gaumer their heirs and assigns, that he is the true and lawful owner of the said premises; and has full power to convey the same; and that the title so conveyed is clear, free, and unincumbered; and further, that he will warrant and defend the same against all claims or claims of all persons whomsoever. Evans his wife who hereby releases her right and expectancy of dower in the said premises, have hereunto set their hands and seals, this thirteenth day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six
