Clark of Floyd County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars, in hand paid by John Griffin of Floyd County State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the said John Griffin the following premises, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to wit; The East half of the South East quarter of Section Five in Township Seventy four, and the West half of the South East quarter of Section Four, in Township Seventy four Range Twenty nine, West, and the East half of the North East and the North West of the North East quarter of Section Thirty three in Township Seventy four North of Range Twenty eight West, Also in Union County Iowa, the South East of the South West quarter of Section Four in Township Seventy three North of Range Twenty eight West. And we do hereby covenant with the said John Griffin that we are lawfully seized of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said —— hereby relinquishes her right of dower to the premises hereinbefore conveyed.
