Know all Men by these presents, That whereas

the following described Real property, viz: The  
North East quarter of North West quarter of Section  
N<sup>o</sup> Twenty nine (29) Township N<sup>o</sup> Seventy seven (77) North; of Range N<sup>o</sup>  
Twenty Eight (28) West 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. Iowa, situated in the County of Mad-  
ison, and State of Iowa, was subject to taxation for the years A.D.  
1859, 1860, 1861, & 1862; and whereas the taxes, assessed upon said real  
property, for the years aforesaid remained due and unpaid at the date of the  
sale hereinafter named; and whereas, the Treasurer of the said County did,  
on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January 1864, by virtue of the authority in him vested  
by law, at the adjourned tax sale begun and publicly held on the third  
Saturday of January A.D 1864, expose to public sale at the Treasurers Office  
in the County aforesaid in substantial conformity with all the requisitions  
of the statute in such case made and provided, the real property above  
described, for the payment of the taxes, interest and costs then due and  
remaining unpaid on said property; and whereas, at the time and  
place aforesaid H. G. Van Meter of the County of Dallas, and State of  
Iowa, having offered to pay the sum of Nine Dollars & Twenty seven  
cents being the whole amount of taxes, interest and costs the due and  
remaining unpaid on said property, for the North East quarter of North  
West quarter of Section N<sup>o</sup> Twenty nine (29) Township N<sup>o</sup> Seventy seven (77)  
North, of Range Twenty eight (28) West 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. Iowa, which was the  
least quantity bid for; and payment of said sum having been by him  
made to the said Treasurer, the said property was stricken off to him at that  
price, and whereas H. G. Van Meter has assigned his certificate of purchase  
to John R. Guthrie of Wayne County, Iowa, and whereas three years has  
elapsed since the date of said sale and the said property has not been  
redeemed therefrom as provided for by law; Now, therefore I, R. A. Stitt  
Treasurer of the County aforesaid, for and in consideration of the said sum  
to the Treasurer paid as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case  
made and provided, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said John R. Guthrie his heirs and assigns  
the real property last hereinbefore described, to have and to hold unto him the  
said John R. Guthrie his heirs and assigns forever; subject however, to all  
the rights of redemption provided by law. In witness whereof I R. A. Stitt
