Know all Men by these presents that we Thomas Osborn and Rachel Ann Osborn of Lee County and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars, in hand paid by Frederick Bissel of Lee County and State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the said Frederick Bissel and to his heirs and assigns the following described premises, to-wit; The West half of the South East quarter of Section No One in Township Seventy-five North of Range No Twenty nine West, containing Eighty Acres more or less, in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, and we do hereby covenant with the said Frederick Bissel that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Rachel Ann Osborn hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
