Clanton of Madison County and State of Iowa, do hereby quit all our right claim and title to the following described premises, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit: The North half of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ quarter Section, and the North $\frac{1}{2}$ half of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ quarter Section of Section No. (23) Twenty three, Township (75) Seventy five North of Range (26) Twenty six West containing (158) One hundred and fifty eight Acres more or less, and the said Matilda Stiffler (wife of Adam Stiffler) hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
