This Indenture, Made the Seventh
day of January, in the year of our Lord
One thousand eight hundred and Sixty seven,

between Riley Corray and Mary Corray his wife, residents of County
of Green and State of Wisconsin, parties of the first part, and
William Rinheart of Madison County State of Iowa party of
the second part. Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part,
for and in consideration of the sum of Sixteen hundred dollars,
to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt
whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, have given, granted,
bargained, sold, remised, released, aliened, conveyed, and confirmed,
and by these presents, do give, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release,
alien, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part
his heirs and assigns forever, the following described lands, com-
mencing at the South West corner of the South East quarter of
Section Four (4) in Township Seventy six (76) Range Twenty seven (27)
in Madison County State of Iowa, thence North One hundred and thirty
Rods, thence East Eighty rods, thence North four Rods, thence East eighty
rods, thence South One hundred and thirty four Rods, thence West One
hundred and sixty Rods to the place of beginning, (S E $\frac{1}{4}$ of 4 - 76 - 27)
Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; and all the estate, right,
title, interest, claim, or demand whatever of the said parties of the first part,
either in law or in equity, either in possession or expectancy of, in and
to the above bargained premises, and their hereditaments and appurtenances.
To have and to hold the said premises as above described, with hereditaments
and appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and
assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part for their heirs, executors,
and administrators, do covenant, grant, bargain and agree to and with
the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns that at the time of
the sealing and delivery of these presents they were well seized of the premises
above described, as of a good, sure, perfect absolute and indefeasible estate,
of Inheritance in the Law, in fee simple; That the same are free and clear
from all encumbrances whatever; And that the above bargained prem-
ises, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second
part, his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons
lawfully claiming the whole or any part thereof, will forever warrant and
defend. In witness whereof, the said parties of the first part have hereunto
