Know all Men by these presents, that we C. S.
 William McCleary McCleary & Mary E. McCleary wife of said C. S.
 McCleary in consideration of the sum of Two hundred
 and fifty dollars to them paid by William McCleary the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant bargain sell and convey to the said
 William McCleary and his heirs except those begotten by his former wife
 Charity McCleary and assigns forever the following described premises situated
 in Madison County and State of Iowa, and described as follows, to wit;
 The South East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No Twenty six
 (26) in Township No Seventy seven (77) of Range No Twenty seven (27) and
 all the Estate, title and Interest of the said C. S. McCleary and Mary E. McCleary
 either in law or in equity of in and to the said premises; Together with
 all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, and all the rents
 issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold the same to the only proper
 use of the said William McCleary and his heirs. The heirs of said William
 McCleary begotten of his former wife Charity McCleary are hereby expressly
 excepted, Also the right of dower in said Charity McCleary is hereby
 expressly excepted in case of the death of said William McCleary.
 And the said C. S. McCleary and Mary E. McCleary for themselves and for
 their heirs executors and administrators do hereby covenant with the
 said William McCleary his said heirs and assigns that they are the true
 and lawful owners of the said premises and have full power to convey
 the same; and that the title so conveyed is clear free and unencumbered
 and further that they will warrant and defend the same against all
 claim or claims of all persons whomsoever. In witness whereof, the said
 C. S. McCleary and Mary E. McCleary his wife hereby releasing right and
 expectancy of dower in the said premises have hereunto set their hands
 and seals this the 31st day of December A.D. 1866, in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and sixty six
