

 whereas the said heirs have sold the said Real Estate to John W.
 Gregory, Therefore we Mary King and John King (husband of Mary King)
 heirs as aforesaid of the County of Green and State of Wisconsin,
 in consideration of One hundred and Forty three dollars in hand
 paid by John W. Gregory of the County of Ringgold and State of Iowa
 do hereby sell and convey unto the said John W. Gregory all our right
 title and interest, it being the one seventh, in and to the following
 described Real Estate, situate in the County of Madison and State
 of Iowa, to-wit; The North half of the North West quarter of Section
 Five, and the East half of the South East quarter of the North West
 quarter of Section Seventeen, and the South West quarter of the South
 East quarter of said Section Seventeen, except a Strip out of said
 forty acre tract in the South East corner thereof it being twenty rods
 wide North and South, and Forty rods long East and West, all in
 Township Seventy four, Range Twenty seven, and we do covenant
 that we are lawfully seized of the said interest herein conveyed and
 we do warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all
 persons whomsoever. And the said John King does hereby relinquish all
