 September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and Sixty six, between John H. Schell of the
 County of Bedford and State of Pennsylvania of the first part,
 and G. W. Rans of Madison County and State of Iowa of the second
 part; Witnesseth; That the said party of the first part, for and in consid-
 eration of the sum of Four hundred dollars lawful money of the
 United States of America, well and truly paid by the said party of
 the second part, to the said party of the first part, at and before the
 sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold, ^{aliened}, enfeoffed, released,
 conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell,

alien, enfeoff, release, convey and confirm, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described piece of land The North East Fraction quarter of the North West fraction quarter of Section '12" Twelve Township Seventy seven 77 North of Range 26 Twenty six West, Together with all and singular, the buildings, improvements, woods, ways, rights, liberties privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the same belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof; And also, all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand, whatever, both in law and equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in, and to the said premises, with the appurtenances; To have and to hold the said premises, with all and singular the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said John H. Schell his heirs, executors and administrators, do by these presents covenant, grant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that him the said John H. Schell, his heirs, all and singular the hereditaments and premises herein above described and granted, or mentioned and intended to be so, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against him the said John H. Schell his heirs, and against all and every other person or persons, whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, shall and will warrant and forever defend.
