hundred and twenty five dollars we
hereby convey to James Harmon the following
Real Estate to wit; Being the North side North West quarter of Section
number six in Township Seventy five North of Range Twenty nine
West supposed to be One hundred Acres more or less. Commencing
at the West line of said Section at the Junction of line at Middle
River thence the center of said River to Island in said River known
as Skidmore's Mill Seat thence on the South side of said River sufficiently
to secure a Mill dam without injury to said Mores land thence back
to the center of said stream thence down to a post on the North bank in
the center bottom known as Black walnut bottom thence through the

bottom to Cotton wood at or near the East line of said quarter section known as the big Cotton wood Coon tree. And warrant the title against all persons whomsoever. In witness whereof, we have hereunto signed our name this the 26th day of August 1854.
