The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:
Certificate N° 11.383. Whereas Patrick Kelley of
Warren County Iowa, has deposited in the General Land Office of the
United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at
Fort Des Moines whereby it appears that full payment has been made
by the said Patrick Kelly according to the provisions of the Act of Congress
of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An act making further provision
for the sale of the public lands" for the North East Fractional quarter
of the South East quarter of Section Twenty five in Township Seventy
seven North, of Range Twenty six West in the district of lands
subject to sale at Fort Des Moines Iowa, containing Thirty nine
Acres and Fifty six hundredths of an Acre, according to the Official
plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land
Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased
by the said Patrick Kelly. Now know ye, That the United States
of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity
with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided,
Have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant,
unto the said Patrick Kelly and to his heirs, the said tract
above described, To have and to hold the same, together with all
the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever
nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Patrick Kelly and to his
heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof, I. Franklin
Pierce, President of the United States of America, have caused
these letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the General Land
Office to be hereunto affixed.

one thousand eight hundred and fifty five, and of the Independence
