So { Affidavit } State of Iowa {

Adair County {

I, John Shreves of Adair County Iowa, being duly sworn do depose and say that I am a son of Minerva Shreves now deceased, that on the 19th day of September A.D. 1851, said Minerva Shreves entered the South West quarter of Section Twenty five in Township Seventy six North; of Range Twenty six West of 5th P.M. in her own name & paid therefor her own means that in the spring of 1856 I bought said tract of land of Minerva Shreves and paid her therefor two thirds of the value of the land & for the remainder I issued to her an obligation to be paid at a future time when Minor heirs of Minerva Shreves become of Age and I have paid said amount to said heirs and that said Minerva Shreves did marry one John Salisbury in the Spring of 1856 and that said Minerva Shreves did make me John Shreves a good Warranty Deed in fee simple to said tract of land, to-wit:

South West quarter of Sec. Twenty five Township 76 North of Range 26 West 5th P.M. Madison Co. Iowa.
