Know all Men by these presents;

That we George Hornback and Dorothy Hornback his wife of Boone County and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars in hand, paid by Mary A. Danforth of Madison County and State of Iowa do hereby sell and convey unto the said Mary A. Danforth the following described premises, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Lots No Seven and Eight (7)(8) in Block No Twenty six (26) in the Original town Plat of Winterset Madison County Iowa, and we hereby covenant with the said Mary A. Danforth that we hold said premises by title in fee simple; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever, and we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Dorothy Hornback hereby relinquish her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
