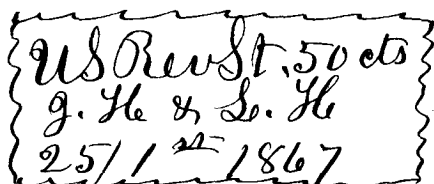
Know all Men by these presents;
