Section Twenty seven (27) in Township Seventy four (74) North  
of Range Twenty seven (27) West, containing Forty Acres, and all  
the Estate, Title and Interest of the said George W. Garrison and  
Susana Garrison wife of the aforesaid George W. Garrison either  
in Law or in Equity, of, in and to the said premises; Together
