to the following property, to wit;

The North West quarter of the North West quarter of
Section (31) Thirty one, in Township (74) Seventy four, in
Range (26) Twenty six, Madison County, Iowa.

The Considerations is, That the said Joseph and
Elizabeth W. McGuire retains possession of the Dwelling
house and kitchen belonging to the farm, together with
the Garden and Orchard, during their lifetime, and that
the said J. N. McGuire shall pay the fourth of all the crops
raised on the balance of the place to the said Joseph and
Elizabeth McGuire in the Crib or Bin during their natural lives.

Now if the said J. N. McGuire shall fulfil these agreements
his title is declared warranty: But if he should fail neglect
or refuse to comply with these articles his title is forfeited
and this deed is null and void
