S. Smith of Brown County and State of Kansas, in consideration of the sum of One hundred & fifty dollars, in hand paid by M. J. Rutledge of Madison County & State of Iowa, do hereby sell & convey unto the said M. J. Rutledge the following described premises situated in the County of Madison & State of Iowa, to wit;

Fifty acres off of the West half of the North half of the North East quarter of Section No Thirty (30) in Township No Seventy six (76) North of Range No Twenty eight (28) West of the 5 P.M. Iowa.

And we hereby covenant with the said Mary J. Rutledge, that we hold said premises by good & perfect title, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell & convey the same; that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomever; and the said Harriet S. Smith hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
