Noah Henley Know all Men by these presents that we
John Hutchings and Lydia Hutchings
his wife of Clark County, Indiana, in
consideration of Seven thousand Eight hundred and eighty
dollars (\$7880) in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey unto Noah
Henley of Clark County and State of Indiana, the following de-
scribed premises, to wit;

The South half of the North West quarter and West half of the
South West quarter of Section Thirty (30), also the West half of the
North West quarter of Section Thirty one (31) all in Township Seventy-
four (74) North of Range No Twenty seven West. Situated in Madison
County, Iowa. Containing altogether 273 $\frac{3}{4}$ Acres more or less,
and being the same land described in a deed from Joseph J. Hutchings
& wife, to John Hutchings executed June 4, 1858 and Recorded in the
Office of the Recorder of said County in Record Book "H" on page 416.

Also the following described premises situated in said County of
Madison and State of Iowa, to wit; The South half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the
North West quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$), and the North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the South West quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section number Thirteen (13) in Township number Seventy four (74) North
of Range number Twenty eight (28) West of 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ P.M. - Containing 160 acres,
more or less, being the same land in the deed of Joseph J. Hutchings
& wife to John Hutchings dated May 6, 1856, & recorded in Recorders
office of said County, Record Book "D" page 447.

And we do hereby covenant with the said Noah Henley that we are
lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from incumbrances;
that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and
we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against
the lawful claims of all persons whomever, and the said Lydia Hutchings
hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in & to the above described premises.
