 So { Deed Know all Men by these presents.
 101 Alfred B. Judd

That we Riley Judd and Orphania J. Judd his wife of Syringham in the County of Berkshire and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars, paid by Alfred B. Judd of Polk County & State of Iowa, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Alfred B. Judd our equal & undivided one half part of the following described parcels of land, to-wit;

The South East quarter of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No One (1), & the East half of the South East quarter of Section No Seven (7), & the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No Ten (10) all in Township No Seventy six (76) North, & the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No Twenty eight (28) in Township No Seventy seven (77) North, & all of Range No Twenty-eight (28) West; — Also the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No Eleven (11) & the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No Five (5) in Township No Seventy six North of Range No Twenty nine (29) West. — Containing in all Two hundred and Eighty acres of land be the same more or less, & lying and being in the County of Madison and State of Iowa.

To have and to hold the afore-granted premises, with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Alfred B. Judd & to his heirs and assigns, to them and their use and behoof forever.

And we the said Riley and Orphania J. Judd for ourselves and our heirs, Executors, and Administrators, do covenant with the said Alfred B. Judd and his heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee of the afore-granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances. — That we have a good right to sell and convey the same to the said Alfred B. Judd as aforesaid; and that we will and our heirs, Executors, and Administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Alfred B. Judd & to his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
