S.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 Sec. 5, Township No. 76 N. of Range No. 29 West in the County of Madison & State of Iowa, & the W 1/2 of S. W. 1/4 Sec. 14. T. 89 N. Range 28 West. in the County of Webster, & the West fractional 1/2 of South West 1/4 Sec. 30, Town 81. N. R. 26 West, in the County of Dallas all in the State of Iowa & containing 190 1/2 acres of land, be the same more or less.

And I do hereby warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, (Tax, title and pre-emption claimants excepted):
