This Indenture, made this fifteenth day of July in
the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and
sixty eight, between James Allin Sen. & Catharine Allin

of the County of McLean and State of Illinois of the first part, and John Magoun of
the County of McLean and State of Illinois of the second part, Witnesseth, That the
said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred &
Sixteen \$160 dollars, to them paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby
grant, bargain, sell convey and confirm, unto the said party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, that certain tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances,
lying and being in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, described as follows, to wit;

The South West quarter of Section Thirty three (33) Township Seventy five (75)
Range Twenty nine, containing One hundred & Sixty Acres more or less.

To have and to hold the aforesaid granted premises, including also the
release and waiver of all right under and benefit of the exemption and home-
stead laws of the state of Illinois, in and to the above described property, to the
said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and
behalf forever. — And the said parties of the first part do hereby, for themselves
and their heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said party of the
second part, his heirs and assigns, that they are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of the
above granted premises; that they are free from incumbrances; that they have good
right to sell and convey the same to the said party of the second part, and that
they and their heirs, executors and administrators, will Warrant and defend
the said tract or parcel of land to the said party of the second part his heirs and
assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
