Greeting; Know ye, That I Merab Hall of  
Columbiana County, Ohio, widow of Nathan

P. Hall deceased, late of same place the Grantor, for divers good causes and  
considerations thereunto moving, especially for Three hundred dollars  
received to our full satisfaction, of C. D. Bevington the Grantee, have  
given, Granted, Remised, Released, and forever Quiet Claimed, and do by these  
presents absolutely Give, Grant, Remise, Release and forever Quiet Claim  
unto the said Grantee to his heirs and assigns forever all such right and  
title as I the said Grantor have or ought to have, in or to the following  
described land, situate in the County of Madison in the State of Iowa:

Being the South West quarter of Section Six, Township  
Seventy seven North of Range Twenty nine West.

To have and to hold the premises aforesaid, unto the said Grantee heirs  
and assigns, so that neither I the said Grantor or my heirs, nor any other  
person or persons claiming title through or under me shall or will hereafter  
claim or demand any right or title to the premises, or any part thereof; but  
they and every one of them, shall by these presents be excluded and forever  
barred, - And I as the widow of said Nathan P. Hall do hereby Remise  
Release, and forever Quiet Claim unto the said Grantee and his heirs, all my  
right and title of Dower in the above described premises.
