Give, Grant, Remise, Release and forever Quit Claim unto the said Grantee to
his heirs and assigns forever all such right and title as we the said
Grantors have or ought to have, in or to the following described Land,
situate in the County of Madison in the State of Iowa.

Being the South West quarter of Section Six, Township
Seventy seven North of Range Twenty nine West.

To have and to hold, the premises aforesaid, unto the said Grantee
heirs and assigns, so that neither we the said Grantors, or our heirs, nor
any other person or persons claiming title through or under us shall or
will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the premises, or any part
thereof; but they and every one of them, shall by these presents be excluded and
forever barred. - And I Abbie W. Hall wife of said Isaac Hall do hereby Remise,
Release, and forever Quit-Claim unto the said Grantee and his heirs, all of my
