causes and considerations thereunto moving, especially for Two hun-  
dred fifty seven dollars, received to our full satisfaction of C. D. Berington  
the Grantee, have Given, Granted, Remised, Released, and Forever Quit Claimed, and  
do by these presents Give, Grant, Remise, Release and forever Quit Claim  
unto the said Grantee to his heirs and assigns forever all such right and  
title as we the said Grantors have or ought to have, in or to the following de-  
scribed land, situate in Madison County in the State of Iowa, being;

The South West quarter of Section Six, Township Seventy seven  
North of Range Twenty nine West.

To have and to hold, the premises aforesaid, unto the said Grantee heirs  
and assigns, so that neither we the said Grantors or our heirs, nor any other  
person or persons claiming title through or under us shall or will hereafter  
claim or demand any right or title to the premises, or any part thereof;  
but they and every one of them, shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.  
And we the wives of said Grantors do hereby Remise, Release, and Forever Quit  
Claim unto the said Grantee and his heirs, all of our right and title of Dower  
in the above described premises.
