The South Eastquarter of Section Seven, Township Seventy seven, North of Range Twenty nine West, and the North East quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Seventy seven North of Range Twenty nine West of the 3<sup>rd</sup> P. M.

To have and to hold, the premises aforesaid, unto the said Grantee heirs and assigns, so that neither I the said Grantor or my heirs, nor any other person or persons claiming title through or under me shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the premises, or any part thereof; but they and every one of them, shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred - And I as the widow of said Nathan P. Hall do hereby remise, release, and forever quit claim unto the said Grantee and his heirs, all my right and title of Dower in the above described premises,
