This Indenture, made this twenty third
 day of March, in the year of our Lord, One
 thousand Eight hundred and Sixty six,

Between Robert Ferris of the County of Ford and State of Illinois
 party of the first part, and Thomas Agan of the same place
 party of the second part. — Witnesseth, That the said party of the
 first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred
 dollars, in hand paid, by the said party of the second part; the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, has Granted, Bargained and
 Sold, and by these presents do Grant bargain and sell, unto the said
 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following
 described lot, piece, or parcel of land, situated in the County of
 Madison and State of Iowa, to wit;

The South West quarter of the North East quarter of
 Section Thirty three (33) Township No Seventy four (74) North
 of Range Twenty eight West, containing forty acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining,
 and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders,
 rents, issues and profits thereof; and all the estate right title, interest,
 claim and demand whatsoever, of the said party of the first
 part, either in law or equity, of, in and to the above bargained
 premises, with the hereditaments and appurtenances;

To have and to hold the said premises above bargained and
 described, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the
 second part, his heirs and assigns forever. —

And the said Robert Ferris party of the first part, hereby expressly,
 waive, release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part,
 his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, all right, title, claim,
 interest and benefit whatever, in, and to the above described, premises and
 each and every part thereof; which is given by, or results from, all laws
 of this state, pertaining to the exemption of homesteads.
 And the said Robert Ferris party of the first part, for his heirs, executors,
 and administrators, do covenant, grant, bargain and agree, to and with
 the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that at the
 time of the sealing and delivery of these presents, he is well seized of
 the premises above conveyed, as of a good, sure, perfect, absolute and
 indefeasible estate of inheritance in law, and in fee simple, and
 has good right, full power and lawful authority to grant, bargain,
 sell and convey the same in manner and form aforesaid and that

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the same are free and clear from all former and other grants, bargains, sales, liens, taxes, assessments and encumbrances, of what kind or nature soever, and the above bargained premises, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof, the said party of the first part shall and will Narrant and forever defend.
