Shultz of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to wit:

The South half of the NE 1/4 of Sec. No. Seven (7) Township No Seventy six (76) North of Range No 28 West of 5<sup>th</sup> P. M. Madison Co. Iowa -

And we do hereby covenant with the said J. J. Shultz that we lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to Warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Jane M. Munger & Frank A. White hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower in and to the above described premises.
