quarter of South East quarter of Section No Ten (10) Township  
Seventy six (76) North Range No Twenty seven (27) West 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. Iowa,  
Containing Eighty Acres according to the original Survey.

And we do hereby covenant with the said Miller R. Tidrick  
that we are lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from  
incumbrances; that we have good right and lawful authority to  
sell the same; and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend,  
the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever;  
and the said Augusta Casady and Cormelia B. Tidrick hereby  
relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises,
