To all to whom these presents shall come greeting;
Whereas, James M. Gorshorn of Louisa
County Iowa, has deposited in the General Land
Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register
of the Land Office at Chariton whereby it appears that
full payment has been made by James M. Gorshorn according
to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled,
"An act making further provision for the sale of the public lands,"
for the - South East quarter of the North East quarter, and the
North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Five in
Township Seventy four North of Range Twenty eight West, in
the District of lands subject to sale at Chariton Iowa, containing
Eighty Acres. - according to the official plat of the Survey of the
said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
General, which said tract has been purchased by the said James
M. Gorshorn. - Now know ye, that the United States of
America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity
with the several Acts of Congress, in such case made and provided,
Have Given and Granted, and by these presents Do Give and Grant,
unto the said James M. Gorshorn and to his heirs, the said Tract
above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all
the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever
nature thereunto belonging, unto the said James M. Gorshorn
and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Franklin Pierce President of the
United States of America, have caused these letters to be made
Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the third
day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and fifty six, and of the Independence of the United States the Eightieth
