J. Lee on the 3rd day of January A.D. 1865 - the said Melchert claiming under said Lee, hereby sell and convey unto the said Henry Melchert the following described Real Estate situate in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The North East quarter of the South East quarter and the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section N^o Five (5) in Township No Seventy four (74) North of Range N^o Twenty-eight (28) West 3rd P. M. -

Reaffirming the warranty in said former deed and covenants that I am the sole surviving heir of said James M. Goshorn and that James M. died seized of said Real Estate.
