To all to whom these presents shall come greeting;

Whereas, Timothy Horn of Madison County

Iowa, has deposited in the General Land Office

of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Des Moines whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Timothy Horn according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the public lands," for -

The South East quarter of the North West quarter, and the South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Thirty three, in Township Seventy seven North of Range Twenty six West in the District of lands subject to sale at Fort Des Moines Iowa. Containing Eighty Acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Timothy Horn. — Now, know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Timothy Horn and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Timothy Horn and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I James Buchanan President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. — Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Thirtieth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven, and of the Independence of the United States the Eighty second.
