That we Thomas Bardick and Ellen Bardick his wife, of Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey, unto Emanuel Sulgrove of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit;

The East half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the South East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Number Eight (8) Township number Seventy six (76) Range Number Twenty eight (28) situated in Madison County State of Iowa.

and we do hereby covenant with the said Emanuel Sulgrove that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises, that they are free from Incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Ellen Bardick hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower in and to the above described premises. — Signed, the twentieth day of November A.D. 1860
