 Twenty six (26) Township Seventy six (76) Range Twenty  
 eight (28) West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M.

And we do hereby covenant  
 to Warrant and Defend said title to the said premises to said  
 Joseph Snyder against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
