Know all Men by these presents,

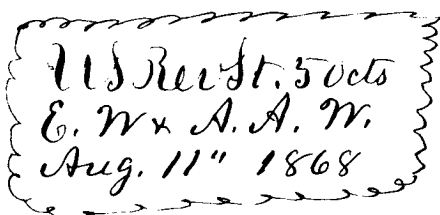
