
This Indenture, made the Twenty sixth day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty eight (1868) Between

Charles S. French and Rebecca his wife of Dixon in the County of Lee and State of Illinois party of the first part, and Mary C. French of the same place party of the second part, - Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the said party of the second part forever released and discharged herefrom, have remise, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed and by these presents do remise, release, sell, convey and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand, which the said party of the first have in and to the following described lot, piece, or parcel, of land, to-wit: situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, and described as. -

The North East quarter of Section number Nineteen (19) in Township number Seventy five (75) North of Range number Twenty eight (28) West. Containing One hundred and Sixty Acres according to the Government Survey.

And the said Rebecca French does hereby convey release and relinquish all contingent rights, including right of dower, which she has or may have in and to said described premises. - To have and to hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging, or in any wise thereunto appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever, of the said party of the first part, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever - In witness whereof, the said party of the first part hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written
